Christmas cards will be on sale from the parish office on Monday, 30th

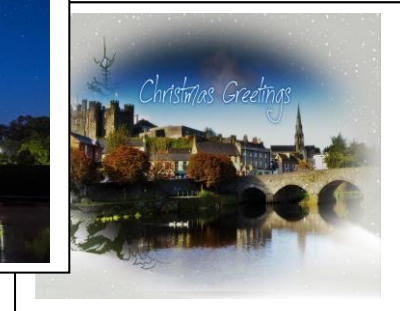
