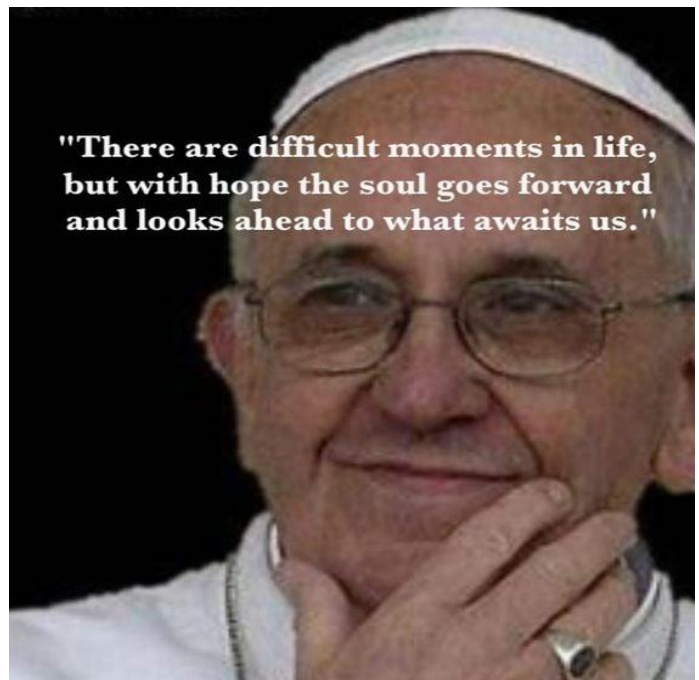

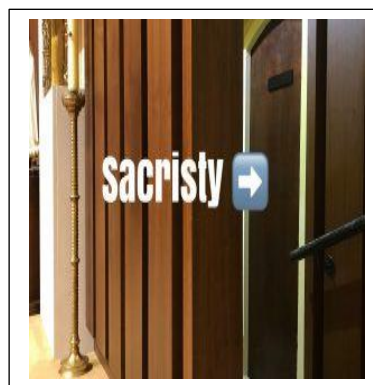
CHURCH OPEN DAILY
