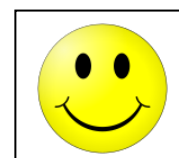

THE HOOK OF FAITH THIS WEEK

This Sunday's Feast of Pentecost prays for a new outpouring of the gifts of the Holy Spirit on the Church. We

explore the gifts of the Spirit and why we need them. Fr Michael O'Shea offers the homily for Pentecost Sunday and the newsletter insert clarifies the difference the Spirit makes to our faith, the liturgy, our spiritual life and moral life.
