## **Update: First Communion & Confirmation 2021**

A response from the Department of the Taoiseach has been received.

Public health advice remains that special religious ceremonies, including First Holy

Communion and Confirmations, should continue to be postponed for the month of June.

In line with the gradual reopening of society, from 5<sup>th</sup> July onwards, we have been told that these ceremonies may take place, while complying with Covid-19 guidance.

Parishes are asked to ensure that all Covid-19 safety measures continue to be followed. Furthermore, given that the more serious concerns relate to the social gatherings which typically follow these events, parishes are asked to remind all concerned to adhere to prevailing public health advice on household mixing and indoor and outdoor gatherings.
