ORDINATION OF BISHOP ELECT GER

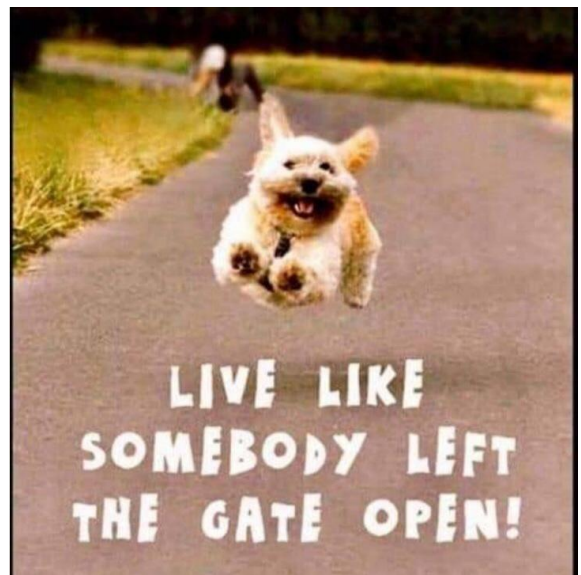
