We are delighted to welcome you to the Parish and look forward to sharing many other occasions with you.

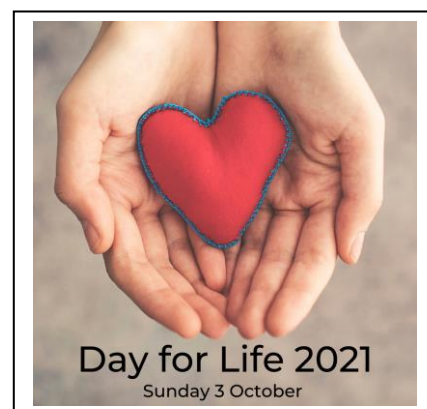
FIRST HOLY COMMUNION **ST. SENAN'S PRIMARY SCHOOL**
