Medjugorje

Occasionally, I ask a question about someone, usually about a serious matter such as a terminal illness or family problem.

In the early days, Our Lady allowed us to ask more questions, perhaps so we could get to know her better.

Later, she still allowed questions, but somehow I knew what I should and shouldn't ask her even before I opened my mouth.

Towards the end of the apparition, she gently raises her hand and says, "In the name of my Son, I give you my motherly blessing."

She puts a slight emphasis on the word "motherly." (Mirjana stresses "slight")

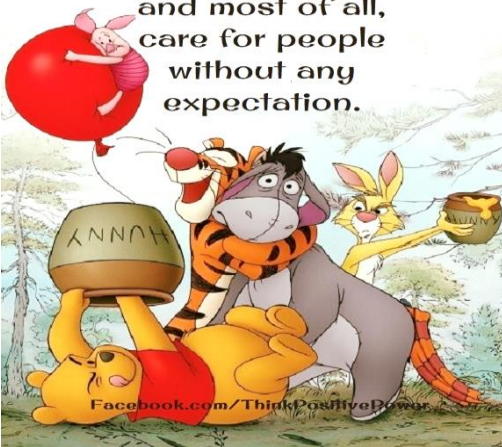
But Our Lady stresses that the blessing of a priest is the blessing of her Son.

Unlike the way a priest gives a blessing, Our Lady does not make the sign of the Cross, she only raises her hand.

She usually concludes by saying, "Pray, pray, pray," and then she rises into the blueness, almost as if being vacuumed away.
