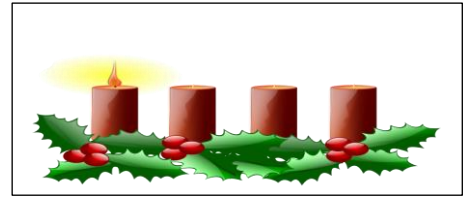

Of course, there's no guarantee that I will be alive when the secrets are revealed. (But many, if not most people familiar with Medjugorje believe she will be)

I have the secrets written, which means I don't have to be alive!

I've kept the parchment in a secure place ever since the UN soldier unknowingly returned it to me.

I could even have it sitting on my living room table and you wouldn't know what it is.

When the time comes, those who need to read it will be able to.

It's possible you're reading this after the secrets have been revealed (you're not!), but if not - if the events foretold by Our Lady have yet to take place and the permanent sign has yet to appear (it has still to appear) - then I urge you not to wait.

Return to God.

Mirjana Soldo, Medjugorje
(The secrets are written on a parchment given to Mirjana by Our Lady. It was left behind in Mirjana's home during the war and the Siege of Sarajevo but a UN soldier later retrieved it - unknowingly - and returned it to Mirjana. A number of people have seen it but each person sees something different.)
