Pope Francis, the devil and the prayer to St. Michael

On Good Friday 2022, Pope Francis said in an interview that was broadcast later on Italian TV that he prays the prayer to St. Michael every day.

“Someone who hears me might say: ‘But, Your Holiness, you have studied, you are the pope, and you still believe in the devil?’ Yes, I believe in him, I believe in him. I am afraid of him; this is why I have to defend myself so much.”

“The devil was the one who did all that manoeuvring so that Jesus would end up like he did, on the Cross. The powers of darkness over Jesus: ‘This is your hour,’ the powers of darkness.”

Note from Fr. Banville:

For sure, such extreme levels of violence - so typical of war too - are always manifestations of the devil's hour but it's the sins of men and women that give the devil his power, it is always our sins that make the devil's hour possible in the first place.

As Jesus laboured to teach; we should fear nothing but sin!

Concert to raise funds for Ukrainian Aid

A huge public response is expected for the Ukrainian Humanitarian Aid Concert which is taking place in St. Mary's Church of Ireland on Saturday night, May 28th.

The concert is being organised by Enniscorthy Lions Club in association with Failte Enniscorthy and will feature some of County Wexford's top entertainers, all of whom are giving their services free of charge.

Enniscorthy is presently home to more than 200 Ukrainian refugees who have been displaced by the war, many of whom have nothing more than the clothes in which they stand. The staging of the concert provides an ideal opportunity for the people of Enniscorthy to show their concern for the plight of the refugees and it is hoped the event will be a sell out so that essential provisions can be provided for those most in need.
