

First Saturday Devotion (Fatima) & Refurbishment of Confessionals

I'm planning to refurbish the two confessionals in the coming weeks, one will return to the old sliding screen format with two separate doors for priest and penitent, the other will remain in an open format. Part of my plan is to wrap the inside of the confession boxes in a vinyl of the Divine Mercy Image together with a general refurbishment/brightening up of the boxes. I will probably wrap the outside too.

I'm hoping to have the work completed for the first Saturday in May when I'll introduce the First Saturday Devotion as requested by Our Lady at Fatima. If the work is not completed in time for May we'll begin on the first Saturday in June.

The devotion involves praying one mystery of the rosary (5 decades), meditating separately for 15 minutes on one of the mysteries (Our Lady calls it "keeping her company"), making a good Confession, and receiving Communion, all with the intention of making reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

It'll mean a little extra work for me but it's something that I feel I should do irrespective of the uptake. At a future point within many of our lifetimes - people will return to Confession in large numbers. I'm just putting the pieces in place, preparing, and ultimately, I'm conscious that I need to be able to stand before Our Lady and say; I may not have made holiness myself, but I did my best to make it possible for others!
