Tuesday Adoration

We continue to struggle to cover adoration on Tuesdays but I've a plan! Until I have sufficient time to organize the day in detail here's the plan:

Scenario 1: You've completed your 30 minutes in adoration but there's nobody arriving to take the next 30 minutes. In that case, you will repose the Blessed Sacrament (repose means remove the Blessed Sacrament from the Monstrance and place in the Tabernacle, lock the Tabernacle and place the key in the key safe - you'll be given the key code.)

Scenario 2: You arrive in the church and the Blessed Sacrament is reposed. Then you simply do the reverse of the above - expose the Blessed Sacrament.

I will be celebrating 7pm Mass this coming week (except Wednesday) and I'll be happy to go through the procedure with you after Mass on an evening that suits you - just give me a shout after Mass.

Mass will take place on Friday, 28th October in St Aidan's Church, Ferns at 7.30pm


