**TOGETHER AGAIN - CD**

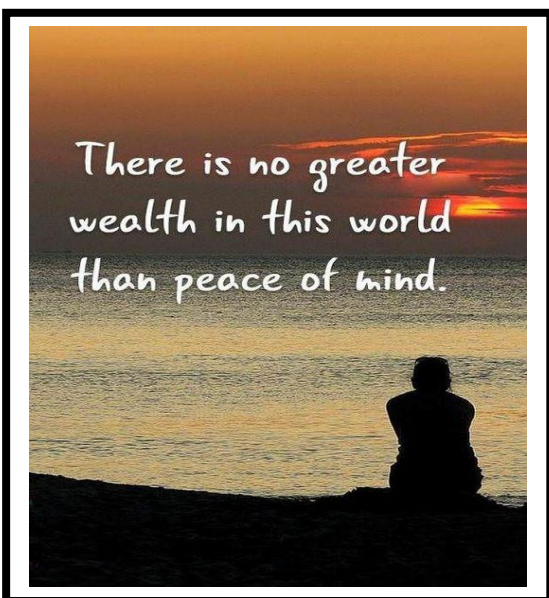
