MARKING 50 YEARS OF TRÓCAIRE IN YOUR PARISH

On the Feast of the Presentation of our Lord in 1973, the Irish Bishops wrote to the Christian people of Ireland establishing Trócaire. As we mark 50 years of Trócaire, we mark 50 years of perseverance, courage, participation, accountability, and solidarity. From supporting human rights defenders in Central America, to leading the relief effort in Vietnam following the war, to providing essential emergency assistance in the midst of crisis, Trócaire has been proud to work on behalf of the people of the island of Ireland in fighting injustice across the world. We thank God for our supporters and partners who empower us to do this vital work. We pray that the next fifty years will see all the people of the world working together for a more just world, and that the fruits of this work will be clear to see.

THE HOOK OF FAITH

In the Gospel this Sunday, Jesus reminds us that faith in him is not just a private but a public matter. He invites us to engage socially and culturally and to be 'salt of the earth' and 'light to the world'. Belatedly, we celebrate 'World Day of Consecrated Life' and mark the annual 'World Day of Prayer and Awareness against Human Trafficking' on Wednesday 8th Feb. – the feast of St Josephine Bakhita. We continue to track the fast-changing shifts in our culture when it comes to respect for life with disturbing news from the Rotonda Maternity Hospital and the ongoing effects of Euthanasia around the world. Finally, we feature a new initiative by the Irish Dominicans called 'Treasure Ireland' – a series of videos that explore Ireland's Christian heritage.
