THE HOOK OF FAITH

The Homily for the Third Sunday of Lent reflects on Jesus's encounter with the woman at the well which has deep literal and spiritual meaning for people who are thirsting for real water like the people of Somalia and us who thirst spiritually for the living God. We reflect on the 10th anniversary of Pope Francis' papacy and include the second of three articles on the prophet Micah's request that we 'Act justly, love tenderly and walk humbly with our God'. As we approach another St Patrick's Day, we reflect on his feast and its connection with Easter. Bishop Robert Barron offers a video talk on 'The Way of Beauty' as a route to evangelise and finally, an online resource from the Council for Catechetics for the celebration of the sacraments of Reconciliation and First Communion.
