

THE HOOK OF FAITH

This week marks the 5th anniversary of the vote that led to the legalisation of abortion in Ireland. The Irish Bishops have released a statement that analyses some of the developments since then and encourages people of faith to change the narrative around the tragedy of abortion. We include Pope Francis' message for 'World Communications Day' in which he invites us to speak from the heart with truth and love.

We also include a recent talk by Pope Francis to farmers in which he reminds them that they are the 'first ecologists' and outlines that farming is not just a job but a vocation. We continue with the video series on the creed and explore how single Catholics can meet their future spouses. Templeshannon Childcare Centre

At Templeshannon Community and Childcare Centre, registration for [Templeshannon Childcare Centre](#) is now open. You can contact us for registration

forms for September 2023. We are happy to have your child registered for our toddler group, preschool group and after school group (in St. Senans Primary School)

ECCE Preschool: free childcare for children born between 1 January 2019 and 31 December 2020 for 3 hours per day.

Toddler Group: Any children who are 2 years old can join our Toddler Group for 3 hours per day for as little as 65c per hour (NCS funding dependent)

Afterschool: Any children attending St Senans Primary School can join our afterschool service between 1:30pm and 4:30pm for as little as €1.25 per hour (NCS funding dependent)

For fee paying places, pay as little as 65c per hour with the National Childcare Scheme. Fees are €5 per hour but NCS can be applied for to get a reduction in fees.
