At Templeshannon Community and Childcare Centre, registration for

[Templeshannon Childcare Centre](#) is now open. You can contact us for registration forms for September 2023. We are happy

to have your child registered for our toddler group, preschool group and after school group (in St. Senans Primary School) ECCE Preschool: free childcare for children born between 1 January 2019 and 31 December 2020 for 3 hours per day. Toddler Group: Any children who are 2 years old can join our Toddler Group for 3 hours per day for as little as 65c per hour (NCS funding dependent)

Afterschool: Any children attending St Senans Primary School can join our afterschool service between 1:30pm and 4:30pm for as little as €1.25 per hour (NCS funding dependent)

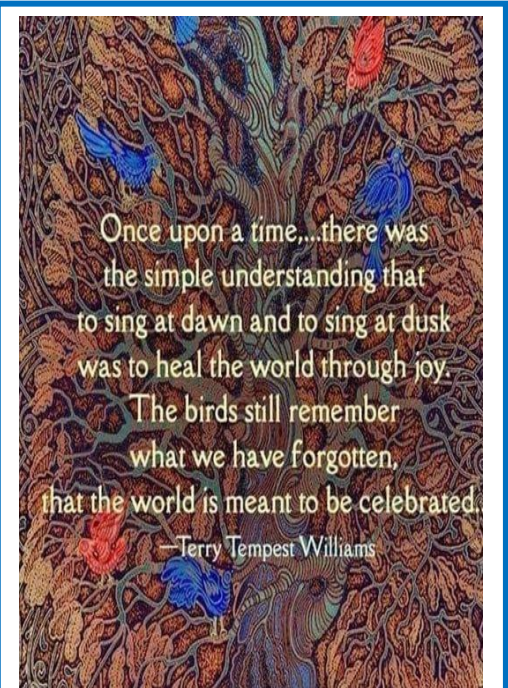
For fee paying places, pay as little as 65c per hour with the National Childcare Scheme. Fees are €5 per hour but NCS can be applied for to get a reduction in fees.
