"God our loving Father, we know that you care deeply for us. We ask you to bless us with the good weather we so badly need at this time. Bless the work and efforts of all your people so that


their endeavours may produce the results they need. Grant success to the work of our hands. We make this prayer through Christ our Lord, Amen."
