THE HOOK OF FAITH

'Synodality Explored: Facing the Future Together' is an article by Jim Thompson who recently attended a conference on synodality in Knock. The homily for the Sixth Sunday of Easter focuses on the fundamental vocation we all share in common, namely to love one another as Christ has loved us. 'For the Formation of Men and Women Religious and Seminarians' is the Pope's Prayer intention for May and we ask the question of whether we Catholics still love the Eucharist and why.
