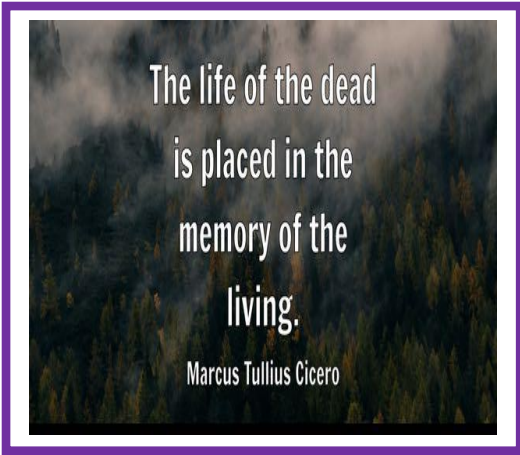
**EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION CHRISTMAS CARDS**
