## Holy Week and Easter

Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week and the final week of Lent including the Triduum, Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Saturday leading to the celebration of Easter, the day of the Lord's resurrection, the most sacred days of the Church's calendar. The Paschal Triduum is the three days leading up to and including Easter Sunday. It begins at sunset on Holy Thursday and ends at sunset on Easter Sunday. If anyone wishes to have water or salt blessed during the Easter Masses, please leave your bottles of water and boxes of Salt into any of the churches in the pastoral area before next weekend marked with your name. You can pick them up after Easter Sunday Mass.
