John Colfer is still working on the figure, there is extra work required as follows:

New Jesus Nazareus Rex Ludaeorum (INRL) sign on top of Cross, carved from Burmese teak.

Crown of thorns replaced with new wood and carved (almost all of it).

More extensive repairs on the abdomen, back, shoulders and arms which will incur extra cost of €2,700.
