THE HOOK OF FAITH

As Pope Leo departs for his Apostolic journey to Turkey and Lebanon, he publishes an Apostolic Letter called 'In the Unity of Faith' to mark the 1,700 anniversary of the Nicaean Creed and the Council of Nicaea which took place outside modern Istanbul.
