Celebrating 50th Anniversary St. Senan's Parish 2026

Sunday of the Word of God – January 25th, 2026

Sunday of the Word of God was established "to be devoted to the celebration, study and dissemination of the Word of God", the Sunday of the Word of God can be marked in the community, in the family, and in personal prayer. The theme for this year is - *"The word of Christ dwells among you"* (Col 3:16).

Feast of St. Brigid - Sunday 1st February

She was born in 451 or 452 at Faughart, near Dundalk, in Ireland. Her name is that of the pagan goddess of fire. She converted to Christianity, inspired by the preaching of St Patrick. She founded a double monastery, of monks and nuns, at Kildare, the first women's monastic community in Ireland, and she died there in 525.

Feast of the Presentation – Monday, 2nd February

Monday, 2nd of February is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord also known as Candlemas Day. It marks the official end to the Christmas season. Candles will be blessed at Mass on this day in St. Aidan's Cathedral at 10am and **St. Senan's at 7pm**. You can leave candles marked with your name on them into either church on or before the day.

Feast of St. Blaise - Tuesday 3rd of February

St. Blaise Bishop and Martyr is the Patron of sore throats, and throats will be blessed after the following Masses:

Marshallstown 9:30am, St. Aidan's 10am and **St. Senan's 7pm**.
