Annual Diocesan Pilgrimages to Knock Shrine on Sunday, 5th July

I look forward once again to leading the Annual Diocesan Pilgrimage to Knock Shrine on Sunday, 5th July 2026. Knock Shrine is a special place of pilgrimage in Co. Mayo, in the west of Ireland, where, on August 21st. 1879, fifteen people witnessed the Apparition of Our Blessed Lady, St. John the Evangelist, and St. Joseph at the gable end of their parish church. The Shrine has a special place in the hearts of not only the people of Ireland, but also of many other nationalities. Presently, one million people visit our national Shrine annually. I am aware that many groups and parishes organise their own pilgrimage to Knock during the pilgrimage season. Could I ask the various groups and parishes to consider joining us on our Annual Pilgrimage to Knock on Sunday 5th July. Those who are organising buses for the Diocesan Pilgrimage to Knock are asked to contact Eileen Carton as we need to inform Knock shrine of the number of buses travelling on the day. This annual pilgrimage offers a sacred opportunity for our entire diocesan family to come together in prayer, reflection, and community. Whether you seek personal renewal, wish to pray for loved ones, or simply want to experience the deep peace of Ireland's National Marian and Eucharistic Shrine, your presence will greatly enrich our pilgrimage. A poster is enclosed for display on the parish noticeboard and I ask you to announce the pilgrimage at weekend Masses and to include details of the pilgrimage in the parish newsletter, on social media and on parish websites. Pilgrims from the diocese of Killaloe will once again join with us this year.
