THE HOOK OF FAITH

The Homily for the Eighteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time is on the miracle of the loaves and fish which prefigures the Lord feeding us at the Eucharist. 'Why I am Not an Atheist' is the title of a new book by Christopher Beha who gives an interview about his rediscovery of faith. 'Be Careful how you Build' is an article on a theme in Pope Leo's 'Magnifica Humanitas' and how we are always building up or tearing down. The 'Saints in a Year' series features St John Vianney and how he can help us appreciate again the sacrament of reconciliation. Bishop Robert Barron explains why young people are converting to the Catholic faith in America and why being virtuous is good for your health. We have features on St Dominic and the Feast of the Lord's Transfiguration which are celebrated this week.
